Brest Maritime Festival was set up in 1992 by a team of classic boats lovers. The 2020 event revives the spirit of cross-culture discovery, attracting in its wake a wide and diverse crowd who gathers enthusiastically.

Mariners from around the world meet up to share their passion for the sea and seafaring experiences. Each event is an opportunity for maritime heritage enthusiasts to polish up their knowledge and admire new sailboats. Newcomers, who often travel long distances to attend, make their dream come true as they cross the gangway of mythical boats.

BREST 2020 International Maritime Festival will be a unique chance for many attendees to go aboard a classic boat and enjoy a memorable experience.

Gatherings are scheduled to let people from all 'Ports of Call' meet their counterparts, as the essence of the event is to bring maritime cultures together.

An Amazing Show

More than one thousand boats from the whole world will be gathering in Brest 2020 for what will be a live exhibition of the maritime past and present : iconic yachts, period replicas, hundred-year-old vessels, racing boats, research and Navy vessels ...

A fascinating and varied display that illustrates Man's many ways to go to sea. Visitors will be looking at docked ships and crafts on the water, right from the wharves and particularly from the La Pérouse Dam – an amazing viewpoint over Brest Bay. And last but not least : mini-cruises will sail hundreds of visitors across the bay !

At dusk, the renowned sea parades feature a magical show that attendees always look forward to with excitement.

The 8th Festival will offer an unprecedented experience with theme parades.

Across the Festival area, visitors will be led through the Festival spaces, the 'Ports of Call' dedicated to each seapeople's culture. These stopovers will all be genuinely featured for an immersion into a variety of atmospheres, inviting visitors on a journey full of moments of thrilling discovery :

- shipbuilding techniques ;
- traditional music and shanty singers ;
- cultures ;
- arts and crafts ;
- food and cooking...

Common projects will include sharing music, dance, sculpture between the delegations across Brest 2020 International Maritime Festival.
